MINUTES DFWMGR MEETING 9/21/10

LINDAY MILLER'S HOME

Guest Speaker: 7pm-8pm

The meeting was called to order by the President at 8:15 pm. There were 21 regular members present and three guests.

The minutes of the last meeting held at Cockleburr Acres in June were read. Motion to accept the minutes was made by Patti, seconded by Molly Chapman and approved by unanimous vote.

The Treasurer was not present, however, a brief report was sent indicating the proceeds gained this year were \$19,000 and the balance in our bank account to date is approximately \$45,000.

The corresponding secretary reported she has received an application for membership from Susan Meagher who resides in Anna, has two registered Golden Retrievers with AKC and UKC. This would be a family membership.

David Dyer is attending his third meeting after submission of application to become a member. Donna Todd made a motion to accept David Dyer and Rhonda seconded the motion. A unanimous vote was received without further discussion.

Dyanna Komensky is attending for the third time after submission of application. Donna Todd made a motion to accept Dyanna and Theresa seconded the nomination. The vote was unanimous without further discussion.

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding the 2013 National Show proposal to be held in the DFW area and hosted by our club. Sherry Farmer presented two options for the venue. One is an indoor option at the Fort Worth Colliseum and the second is an outdoor option at South Fork ranch. This event is proposed to be held the last full week of October, 2013 spanning two weekends.

Costs for South Fork are as follows: \$25,000 deposit and land charge, \$15,000 for tents, \$3,500 miscellaneous for security, \$225 per week for RV hookups of which \$100 per week is for generators, \$800 for four golf carts, \$6,000 for large generators for grooming tents, etc. The total cost is now over \$52,000.

Sherry related this is a huge commitment and there is a real concern over the ability of volunteers to devote an entire week to the project. After much discussion the president said that we will relate to the GRCA that we are still considering the event, but in the absence of complete information, we are unable to make a decision at this time. Everyone felt we are willing to make it work.

A suggestion to procure insurance to protect our \$25,000 deposit in the event of bankruptcy was noted. We agreed to also consider the Texas Motor Speedway venue.

The President reminded the group that the nominating committee consisting of Nancy Crowley, Kathy Felix, Theresa McKenna, David Brown and Jane Horswell is working and will be contacting members to fill the ballot in October.

The October meeting is a Halloween Costume Party and includes a costume contest for dogs over six years of age. The meeting will be held at the Houn' House. It is a pot luck meal with members bringing side dishes and desserts.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Janet, seconded by Linda Williams and unanimously approved at 10:04 pm.
