Below are some suggestions/ideas and costs for the breakfasts. You are welcome to pick and choose from the options. Additionally, you will be charged 7 percent sales tax on whatever you choose and a delivery charge which is calculated on the amount of food purchased.

Breakfast for 200 would be 13 gallons of coffee and 17 dozen breakfast items – cheapest it could be would be \$669.00 for coffee and assorted bakeries.

Breakfast for 300 would be 19 gallons of coffee and 25 dozen breakfast items – cheapest it could be - \$981.00 for coffee and assorted bakeries.
